Henderson County School System offers several virtual opportunities. If you are currently exploring educational options for your child due to health concerns or other reasons, Henderson County Schools' virtual opportunities will offer you flexibility, convenience, and peace of mind.

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT HENDERSON COUNTY VIRTUAL OPPORTUNITIES

- Henderson County offers virtual classrooms from Kindergarten through
 12th grade. Every school in Henderson County has a Virtual
 Opportunity. Enrolling in one of our Virtual Opportunities will allow your child to
 participate in school activities such as athletics, clubs, special classes, and schoolwide events. This will help maintain relationships in your local school community
 and provide a seamless transition should you decide to return to the brick and
 mortar school.
- Since these virtual classrooms are already integrated into each local school, parents do not have to transfer their students or provide any additional records.
- It is free. Enrolling in a virtual opportunity is free of charge, however, parents will be responsible for providing an electronic device and maintain internet access throughout the school year. It is recommended that you have high-speed internet and a laptop, Chromebook, or a desktop computer.
- All Virtual Opportunities will be staffed with highly qualified teachers from the Henderson County School District. You and your student will have access to these teachers for instruction. Content is provided through a self-paced online program that students can complete on a schedule that parents and their teachers help set for them. There are school requirements to be met for every 9 weeks, semester, and year. However, the day to day schedule is for the parents and their teacher to create.
- Students in need of additional help may have access to more services with weekly in-person meetings or through video conferencing.
- Students who are enrolled in a Henderson County Virtual Opportunity may participate in the free breakfast and lunch program with limited options provided every day for pickup.
