Jackson was chosen from a strong pool of applicants, which included small and midsize cities from across the United States.

The Lab and its partners will provide technical assistance to these cities in areas such as data analysis, community engagement, and policy implementation, while local housing officials will share insights and build connections based on their shared expertise.
