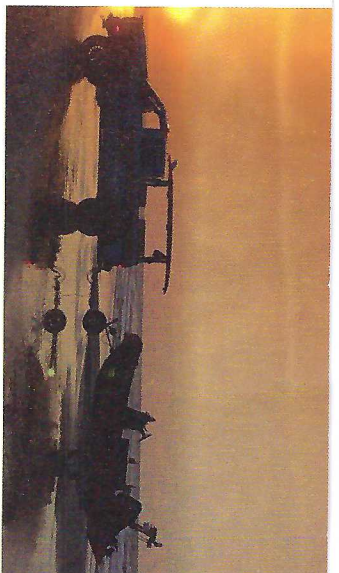
The North Myrtle Beach Rescue Squad has been providing **free** emergency medical care to the community since 1958. We **never** send a bill to patients or insurance companies.

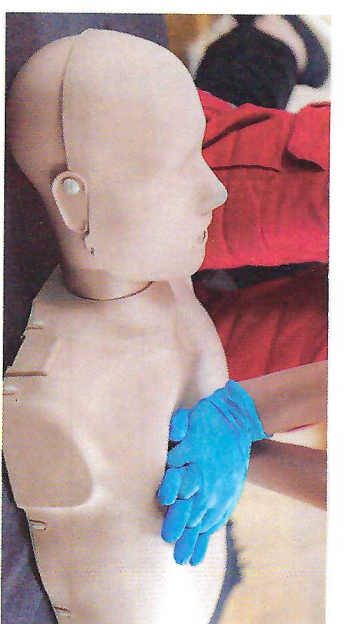
Our water rescue program has evolved into one of the premier ocean and freshwater rescue services in South Carolina. The team is an active resource for use by the US Coast Guard, the SC Department of Natural Resources, Horry County Fire Rescue, North Myrtle Beach and Myrtle Beach city governments.

We respond to:

- ♦ swimmers/boaters in distress
- ♦ overturned boats
- ♦ jet ski crashes
- ♦ aquatic search and rescue
- ♦ vehicles in water
- ♦ medical emergencies on boats
- ♦ aircraft emergencies in water
- ♦ post-hurricane search and rescue

This full spectrum response covers the Atlantic Ocean, Intracoastal Waterway from the NC/SC state line to Georgetown County, SC, the Waccamaw River, and all static water sources within our primary response area.

New for 2022 is the very first amphibious water rescue boat in the United States. Stay tuned!
